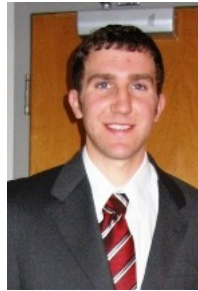


# The Impact

**The Educational Foundation of the Alabama Society of CPAs awards \$1,500 scholarships to one student at every Alabama college and university with an accredited accounting program.**

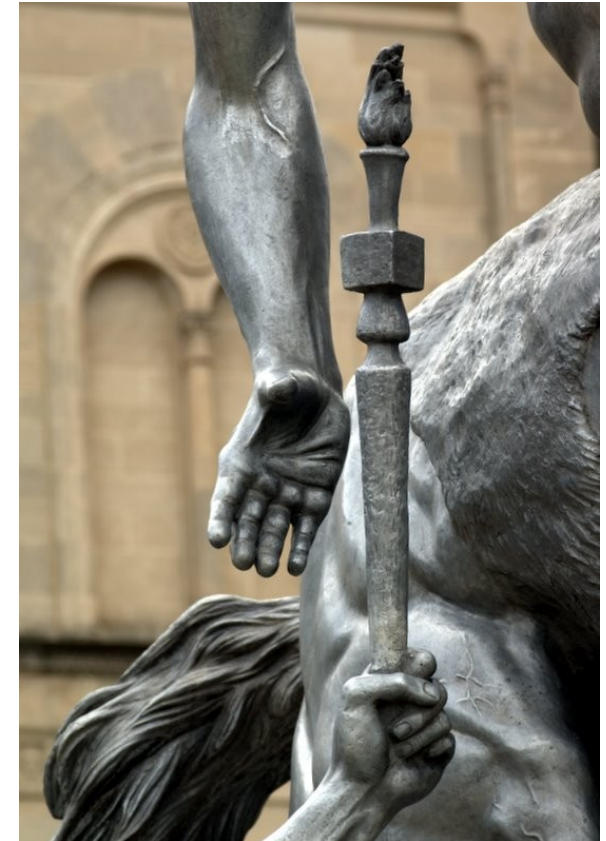
**\$33,000 in scholarships were awarded for the 2008/09 academic year.**
